I greet you all in the Holy Name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. By lots of prayers and Gods direction our name is changed from the IPCC Children's Home to NEW HOPE CHILDREN'S HOME.

We are very happy and an honor to submit this report to the partners in prayer.

While in this long sojourn since 1984, in obedience to the call and vision of our God Almighty, and continuing in the Church-planting ministry, God gave me a prayerful helpmeet, Ruth, in the year 1990 as a precious gift of life. He recognized our desire to serve the orphanage my father began, and at that time entrusted 17 orphans to our care. Today, God has miraculously increased the orphanage to 100 boys and girls and made our campus a lovely care and share center. I am grateful to Him for choosing me and my wife for this wonderful and meaningful ministry, and to carryout His plans for the marginalized and destitute of our society. I am also grateful to all of the donors who have helped the ministry for many years through their prayers and financial support.

God has revealed another vision to us recently, a burden to help the victims of HIV/AIDS as well as their families and children. Many are dying before the appointed time of God due to this dreadful disease. Some innocent children inherit the disease through their parents. They lose their parents and society isolates them. They crave love, and need medicine, food, clothing, and shelter. To comfort such ill-fated children we must show them the active love of Christ by providing food, clothing, and medicine. This has become a very big task and we are earnestly praying for the ability to meet this challenge according to the vision of our mighty God.

All the members of New Hope Church in Chillakallu have persisted in prayer in obedience to the vision of God, and contributed their mite to this cause so we could provide food and clothing to 32 HIV affected children last month. We, along with the leaders and elders of the church, demonstrated the love of our Lord Jesus Christ to these precious children, and were grateful for the gracious loving hands that helped us. Necessary medicine is being supplied by the Indian government, but New Hope Ministries has taken up the challenge of Christ to provide the basic needs for these children such as food, clothing and shelter. We are praying that they will not be punished or experience any more suffering for the transgressions and disobedience of their parents. They should be able to live their lives happily as other children do and glorify God amidst their difficulties. I would humbly request that you would pray along with us for help for these unfortunate children. May His love and grace lead you as you pray and give so together we may stand for the HIV/AIDS stricken children in this society!

Once again we thank you for your prayers and support and ask God that what roles you can play in helping us achieve our goals for His glory.
